- Skara Brae is an archeological site in Orkney, Scotland. It is a Stone Age village. There are 8 houses made of stone. There is only one room in each house. It is famous because it has been well preserved and has taught us a lot about life in the Stone Age.
- The Stone Age is thought to have begun in 2,600,00 BC.
- The Stone age people had to become hunter-gatherers. They had to find animals, kills them for food, shelter and clothes.
- People in the Stone Age used stone as tools.
- The Stone Age people were the first to discover and use fire. Fire was not just used for warmth and cooking, but also for protection and wild animals.
- People in the Stone Age learned how to make pottery, which they used to gather and store liquids. They also made woven baskets to gather and store dry goods, which gave their food a longer 'shelf life' before it spoiled.
- Stone Age/Bronze Age/Iron Age overlapped between 8000BC-43AD.
- There were significant changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.
- The Stone Age was when the mfirst humans began to live in Europe. They used stones as tools.
- The Iron Age is when humans used iron to make tools, and farmed land instead of hunting. They lived in communities.
- The Bronze Age is when metals were used to make hunting tools.
